This experience will provide guests with a morning of adventure in pure luxury. This morning it is off to explore one of Cape Town's hidden treasures, an offroad dune paradise. Way off the beaten track, along the West Coast north of of Blaauwberg Strand, where the only prisoner ever to escape Robben Island landed.

Guests will again be allowed to pilot a Land Rover Discovery (LR4) in a safe and protected setting along the North Atlantic coast on one of the region's largest sand dune fields. In this amazing white sand setting, the luxurious adventurer will be taught important skills and allowed to pilot a vehicle across the sands. After a dose of fun and some adrenaline, a gourmet picnic will be catered for on the dunes.

Enjoy uninterrupted views of Table Mountain and Robben Island from one of the many vantage points.

The Spice-Route was inspired to bring together artisanal food crafters and craftsman of arts together into a space where they could be enjoyed. Here, you will find everything bears its creator's personal touch. From single origin chocolatiers to craft brewers of beer, to glass-blowers, to a distillery and a confectioners bakery that will delight you. "The vision for Spice Route is to offer visitors a selection of hand-picked artisanal producers who put as much thought, skill and passion into their products, as the wine-makers of the Cape Winelands put into their wine. If time permits drive past Victor Verster Prison, from where Nelson Mandela was finally released in 1990, after his 27 year period of incarceration. The drive amongst the mountains, farms, vineyards and sand dunes all culminates to offer guest touring with Ellerman House a day where their fun and pleasure is by design.

FAMILY URBAN & TABLE MOUNTAIN TOUR

Beginning at Sea Level and ending 1085 Meters higher on Table Mountain, this day focus on exploring the Atlantic Seaboard in a fun and engaging way for children. Following in the footsteps of 'Stan the Strandloper' we will take in the city sites before seeing them from a different perspective on the mountain top. The day will begin by Stand-up Paddling and Shell collecting at Camps Bay Tidal Pool. We will then commence a Treasure Hunt in the footsteps of 'Stan the Strandloper'. This is a fun and engaging 3-5 km treasure hunt along the Atlantic Seaboard, using a GPS and Treasure Map - the children follow various clues between the art works on the Sea Point Promenade. At the Green Point Biodiversity Garden the children will be able to taste and smell all kinds of fynbos to create their own brew under the guidance of the guide. Stopping for a picnic on route we will summit Table Mountain taking in the 360 views while tracking Dassies (Mountain Rock Rabbits) that can often be spotted on the table top. We will finish the day with an afternoon tea picnic.

The very first fragment of land 'gifted' to the Muslim community by the Dutch, is easily identified by the colourful homes of the residents. Many theories linger as to the genesis of this animated colour palate chosen for the buildings, all of which will be delved into by your guide. 

EXPLORE THE PENINSULA

INCREDIBLE VISTAS

The most Southwestern tip of Africa, Cape Point, is where it is fabled that two oceans meet. Learn how the treacherous rocks running along the Atlantic Seaboard came to be known as the "Ship Graveyard" or why Bartholomew Diaz called the this place "Cabo de Tormentas" (Portuguese for: Cape of Storms) and what changed in the 200 years following that caused Jan Van Riebeeck to anchor in Table Bay and proclaim it, "Die Kaap van Goede Hoop" (Dutch for: The Cape of Good Hope). Cape Town's Chapman's Peak drive is both dramatic and beautiful. Hugging the face of Chapman's Peak Mountain, this pass offers breathtaking vantage points that rise up to 593 meters above sea level. Driving along this particular route is special in that it offers views at every one of its 114 curves that necessitate, slow careful driving, allowing one to enjoy it all the more.

AT ONE WITH NATURE

The residence of the African Penguin, famous for its animated displays is on Boulder's Beach in Simonstown. Here is where the Cape's nature takes center stage, as the birds put on an animated display. The uniquely conceptualized Boulders Beach penguin interaction allows the animals to freely roam while guests are restricted to a generous boardwalk. One is able to view the African Penguin in its natural habitat without disturbing or infringing. Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve will provide you with an opportunity to view animals like the Cape Mountain Zebra, the mischievous Baboon and the blissful Ostrich, all of which reside in the reserve. At Cape Point Nature Reserve one can also find a plethora of one of the Cape's most outstanding natural attributes, the "Fynbos Floral Kingdom" that is indigenous to this region.

R44 MARINE 4X4 SAFARI & ELGIN VALLEY

The scenic R44 follows the coast all the way from Cape Town's False Bay. Look out for whales and dolphins as you head towards Walker Bay – known for some of the best land-based whale-watching in South Africa. On the way we'll stop at Betty's Bay to visit its resident colony of African penguins, plus the fascinating Harold Porter National Botanical Gardens, home to more plant species than any other garden in the world. Your guide will show you how to make use of traditional plants, perhaps preparing fresh iced tea, as you explore the nature trails that lead up into Disa and Leopard's Kloof.

Next, head inland into the Elgin Valley with its wealth of hiking and mountain bike trails. Our return to Cape Town brings us over Sir Lowry's Pass, with incredible views across the city and back along the R44 coastal road. ART IN THE WINELANDS TOUR

The gallery at **GRANDE PROVENCE** has established itself as a leading location for contemporary art. The gallery features all the visual art forms. The exhibition usually changes every 6 weeks. At The Shop a diverse variety of high quality South African art and craft can be seen in the context of an interior environment. The Shop offers opportunity to purchase works by artists and craft people. Grande Provence specialises in sculpture, making the sculpture garden and indoor sculptures a special attraction.

*Guests can choose to add a canapé and wine pairing to their Grande Provence visit.

Still in the Franschhoek Valley and only a short distance away, we visit **LA MOTTE**. The museum there offers a stimulating culturally historical experience with displays depicting aspects of the Rupert family and Cape Dutch architecture. The large gallery is dedicated to the life of one of South Arica's greatest masters, Jacob Hendrik Pierneef (as seen in the Ellerman House lounge). The work of several leading contemporary artists can also be seen at La Motte. *Guests can choose to add a winelands tea to their La Motte visit.

The next stop is **DELAIRE GRAFF ESTATE** nestled between the majestic mountains and overlooking the vineyards of Stellenbosch. The striking Cape Dutch architecture meets African artefacts and styling representing some of South Africa's finest contemporary artists such as William Kentridge, Lionel Smit, Dylan Lewis and Deborah Bell.

The last vineyard, **TOKARA**, is the embodiment of GT Ferreira's philosophy that good wine, good food and good art go together to make a good life. Some of the finest artworks by contemporary artists such as the wood carving by Egon Tanya and Marco Cianfanelli's laser cut sculpture 'Mine Vine' which stands at the winery entrance area is a must-see experience. Works by diverse artists such as Conrad Botes, Brett Murray and William Kentridge form part of the visual experience at Tokara.

Guests will also be taken to the magnificent **DYLAN LEWIS SCULPTURE GARDEN** where they will be taken on a tour through his studio and workshop. The garden is a beautifully landscaped area surrounded by the Stellenbosch mountains and include larger-than-life sculptures of the artist.



The tour of the museum will take approximately two hours and our art guide will explain seminal artworks exhibited across the four floors inside the building. The guests will be guided through the themes and mediums explored by some of Africa's leading contemporary artists.

CONSTANTIA GLEN

Cradled between the slopes of Constantiaberg and False Bay, Constantia Glen is 60 hectares of magnificent views of the ocean. Guests will learn about viticulture practise and the history of the farm while making their way down to the tasting room through the vineyards. There you will taste four wines paired with a selection of local cheeses and charcuterie while taking in the breathtaking views of the surroundings.

EAGLE'S NEST

The origin of Eagle's Nest can be traced back to 1836 when it was used as a stop between the area now know as Wynberg in the east and the harbour of Hout Bay in the west. The farm specialises in Shiraz, Merlot and Viognier after extensive research was done to better understand the terroir and climate of the area. The vineyards are planted on some of the steepest agricultural slopes in South Africa resulting in the use of a unique terracing system to maximise the amount of sunlight. Guests will be taken on a private and exclusive Land Rover tour to the highest point on the estate for a unique wine tasting.

KLEIN CONSTANTIA

Dating back to 1685, Klein Constantia has been described as one of the world's most beautiful wine farms. Set between ancient trees on the upper foothills of the Constantiaberg with breathtaking views of False Bay. The farm produces some of South Africa's top wines, including one of the world's best natural sweet wine, Vin de Constance. Guests will learn about the unique history of the iconic wines of the Cape and how it put Constantia on the map in the 1700s. A private cellar tour will follow with a tasting of current and older vintages.

If weather permits, guest will be taken for a drive through the vineyards and taste the famous Vin de Constance.
