DIVERSIONS

Praslin

Visit UNESCO World Heritage Site Vallée de Mai Nature Reserve. A remarkably picturesque, must-visit island with a friendly population and plenty to see.

La Digue

The fourth largest island of the Seychelles is great for a day trip. Locals get around by bicycle and ox-cart, which makes it a charming escape from the norm.

Aride Bird Reserve

Take a helicopter to visit this designated Special Nature Reserve that is home to several unique sea bird species. Picnic on the beach after a private ranger tour.

Cerf

Spot sea turtles and sea urchins in the reefs surrounding this small granitic island with no roads and barely any infrastructure.

Sir Selwyn-Selwyn Clarke Market

Dating back to the mid 19th century, this market has an amazing variety of fruit, vegetables, spices, fish and plenty of souvenirs, from sarongs to coconut oil. Speak to stallholders and pick up recipe tips and anecdotes.



National Botanical Gardens

Stroll to the south of Victoria to spend some time in five artfully landscaped acres, where you'll find native plants and a staggering orchid display. Also look out for the giant Aldabra tortoises and fruit bats who call the gardens their home.

Yacht trips

Hire a private yacht for the day and visit remote islands to lay on pristine sands with no one around.

Hikes

Discover the untouched beauty of the Seychelles islands, hiking through thousand-year-old gardens, forest and wander around the endemic plants.

TRAVEL NOTES FOR A SEAMLESS JOURNEY TO THE SEYCHELLES

English is widely spoken in the Seychelles, along with French and Creole. The people are extremely hospitable and friendly. The islands are predominantly Roman Catholic with a sprinkling of other religions.

The climate is tropical, which means attractive temperatures all year round, between 27 C – 31C, although there is a monsoon season between November and March. The Seychelles benefit from around 12 hours of sunshine every day, due to its equatorial location. Rains can be unpredictable, so bring some clothes for wet weather.

The Seychelles do not observe daylight savings time. GMT+4.



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
