# ALL ABOARD THE GLACIER EXPRESS

In eight hours, the panoramic train conveys its passengers from St Moritz via Andermatt to Zermatt or vice versa. The Glacier Express crosses 291 bridges and travels through 91 tunnels along the way.

Thanks to extra-large windows, the panoramic carriages offer an unrestricted view of craggy steep rock faces, untouched forests and deep gorges.

The train ride also leads past delightful plains, rock formations and crystal-clear mountain lakes.

# SASSO SAN GOTTARDO
