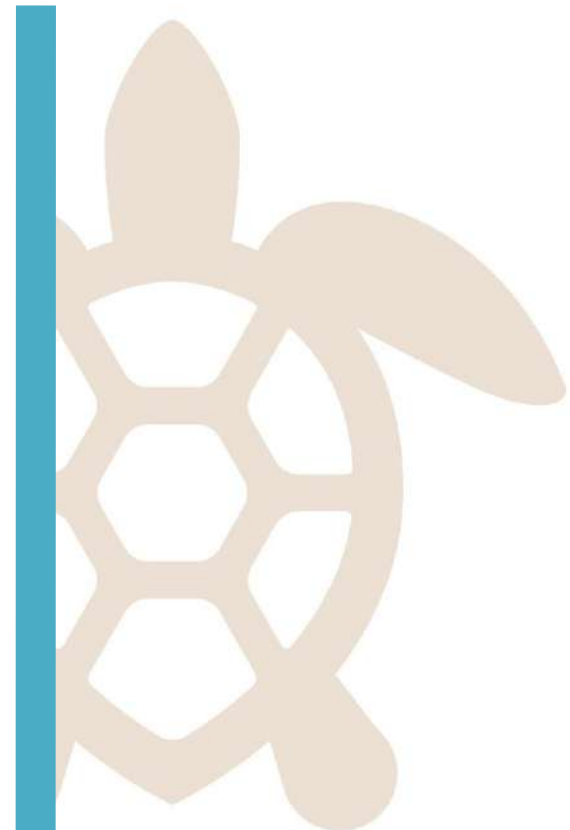

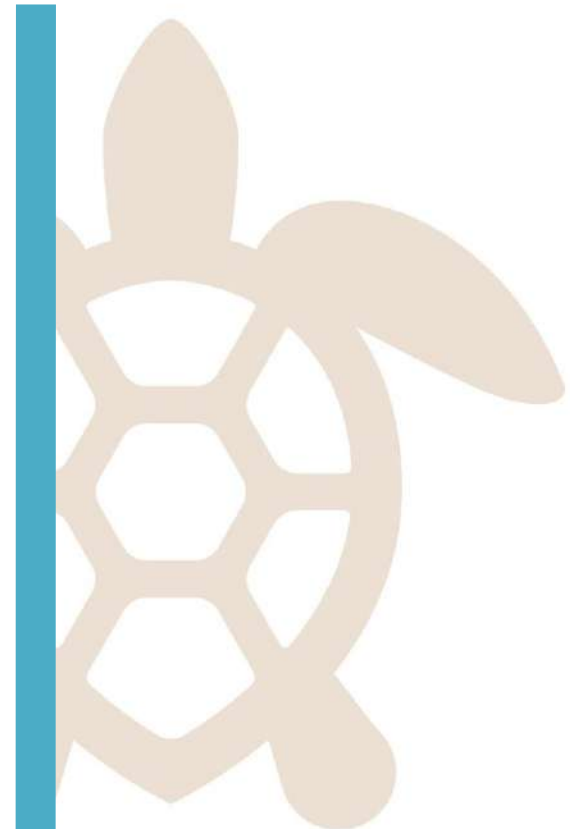

# « The ultimate tour »

This excursion takes you to the hidden treasures of Tetiaroa Atoll accompanied by a naturalist guide from the Tetiaroa Society.

A boat ride leads you to the motu (islets) of the east and north where you can discover the different ecosystems of the atoll.

Primary forest, stingrays and eagle rays, "black tip" and "lemon" sharks, jacks and mullets but also sea birds will surely be there.

Finally, enjoy a relaxing break and swim on a fine sandbar offering a magnificent panoramic view of the whole atoll.

# « The Rimatuu exploration »

Come and discover the history of Tetiaroa!

A boat ride leads you to the motu (islet) of Rimatu'u where you will discover the importance of the atoll from an economic, religious and historical point of view.

This tour starts on the Southwest beach of Rimatu'u and leads you to the ancient village where our Tetiaroa Society guide will share with you the history of the passing of Tetiaroa, from the Pomare to Marlon Brando.

## « The Bird Tour »

Tetiaroa is a nesting site for seabirds and a privileged observation area for birders.

## « The Reef Quest »

This 2-hour guided snorkeling is the best way to discover the coral reefs and the fauna and flora of Tetiaroa lagoon.

# « The kayak exploration »

Accompanied by a Tetiaroa Society guide, slowly sail up the hoa (pass between two islets) that separates Hiraanae and Auroa.

On the way, walk along the outer shores of the motus, observe nesting seabirds, while schools of multicolored fish swim under your kayak.

The complete tour lasts 2 hours including a little bit more than 1 hour of kayaking.
